Waggin' Tales (3)

Autumn Greetings,

In past newsletters and via other media, we've expressed how much we appreciate the ongoing generosity of the citizens of McDonough County and the quick response of community members when shelter supplies are in short supply or when special assistance is required to help an animal in need. What is also extremely valuable to us is the creative thinking of individuals who take the initiative to make things happen — all for the benefit of needy animals. The various efforts to raise funds to build the new animal shelter exemplify this creativity and commitment, as does Lars Gossel's *Foster Village* to address the overflow of dogs at the shelter.

Lars has fostered dogs with special needs for us for a number of years — usually one dog at a time until they find homes. However, this spring and summer there has been what seems like a record number of dogs either released to the shelter or picked up as strays and not claimed. They tend to be great dogs, usually healthy and good-natured. Through either being let down by their humans or just by a "simple twist of fate" they have found themselves at the shelter. In consultation with the HSMC Board and shelter staff, Lars moved forward with a plan to create a *foster village*, with separate housing in a fenced-in pasture adjacent to Gossel's Doghouse. Shelter dogs have separate doghouses with enclosed patios and a large grassy area in which to play and interact with visitors. Lars has also built a *foster village of volunteers* who come play with the dogs and take them into town for events and promotion. He has accomplished this by asking for help from the public — both for building supplies and for volunteer hours. He has an account established at West Side Lumber for donations to cover expenses for the *foster village* facilities.

Dr. Karen Blakely created the *Have A Heart Build a Dream* a project to help raise funds for the new animal shelter building. One of the three fiberglass Rocky bulldogs that stand beside All Pets was looking a bit worse for wear. He is the original alpha dog Rocky from Rocky On Parade Round 1 (2013), making him 11 years old. Dr. Blakeley decided he needed some TLC and took him home. She spent many hours this summer giving him a complete "check up" (sanding to remove the flaky clear coat and chipped paint) and" surgery " (bondo to repair several cracks and holes). Then after painting him, she covered him with painted hearts. The hearts are being sold to the pubic to honor past or present pets. A special section is reserved to honor law enforcement K-9 dogs.

We can't neglect to mention the Community Cat Project folks (Claire Kernek and Charlotte Durkin) and the work they are doing to care for the community cats on the Square and beyond in Macomb. Laci Joy has also opened up Crafty Coop as a space to raise and promote some of these potential feline friends. The list could go on and on. We are blessed.






Build a Dream
